



Charlotte County Public Schools – Form 2520-1 Petition for Objection to the Adoption of Instructional Materials

NOTE: The only petitions accepted for consideration must be from a parent of a public school student in Charlotte County or a resident of Charlotte County [HB 989, Instructional Materials; F.S.(1006.28(1)(a)(3)]. Determination of Charlotte County residency will be made by the submission of two or more documents identified below. The petitioner is to attach required documentation to Form 2520-1 at the time of initial submission to the Division of Learning for the petition to be acknowledged.

- Florida Driver’s License or state of Florida issued I.D. card
- Florida Vehicle Registration
- Proof of home in Charlotte County (document such as deed or other evidence of title to property used as residence, utility bill, etc.)

This petition must include a written signature, the required contact information, and state the objection to the instructional material based on the criteria of s. 1006.31(2) or s. 1006.40(3)(d). Only those petitions timely received will be heard at an open public hearing before an unbiased and qualified hearing officer. The School Board’s decision after convening a hearing is final and not subject to further petition or review. Textual evidence must be supplied for review.
