After reviewing your request to enroll the student(s) listed above, the enrollment request has been denied. This determination was based upon one or more of the following considerations:

- The school you selected does not have space for additional students at your child's grade level and/or program.
- The school you selected is not located in the attendance area where you live. Your child can attend the school, but transportation will not be provided, since your child(ren) did not attend that school prior to becoming homeless.
- You live within the two-mile walk area of selected school.
- Your child needs bilingual or special education services and the school you selected does not have the services your child needs.
- Your child was previously expelled from the school you selected, and may not return to that school.
- Your child was expelled from a school in another district. The Charlotte County Public Schools recognizes the sanction(s) of a previous school, and will assign your child after a review by the Suspension Expulsion Review Team (SERT).
