Articulation Agreements

In order to extend opportunities for postsecondary degrees and certificates, several types of articulation agreements have been developed for CTE students to earn both college and other postsecondary credit for courses completed in high school.

Statewide Career and Technical Education Articulation Agreements

The “Gold Standard” articulation is based on passing the Industry Certification examination in the student’s program of study. The other statewide agreement is for students who have completed a postsecondary program and leads to an AAS/AS Degree.

Johnson and Wales University

Completion of Charlotte Technical Center's Commercial Foods and Culinary Arts program leads to 9 college credits toward an A.S. Degree in Culinary Arts.

Keiser University
